Add -er for the comparative and -est for the superlative. If the adjective has a consonant + single vowel + consonant spelling, the final consonant must be ...

Comparative and superlative adjectives exercises and ...

When we want to compare two or more nouns using adjectives, we use the comparative and superlative forms of the adjective to show the comparison between the nouns.. E.g. Honey is sweet, sugar is sweeter but victory is the sweetest.. In this sentence, we are comparing the three nouns using the positive, comparative and superlative forms of the word 'sweet'.

The rules for superlatives are similar to comparatives. Let's review this chart. For superlatives, if adjectives are one or two syllables, you just add est to the end. For some two syllable adjectives or three or more syllable adjectives you would use most plus the adjective or least plus the adjective.
