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### Cash Management Policies | Standard Practice Guides ...

All cash handling units must maintain written policies and procedures of their cash handling, recording and reconciliation processes. These policies should include procedures for ensuring segregation of duties.

### How do I Write a Cash Management Policy? (with pictures)

Where this is impractical and where the total deposit is less than \$500, the deposit may be made within one business day of collection. This policy will protect university funds as well as facilitate proper cash management. All currency deposits must be in U.S. dollars.
