The war also expanded America's involvement in Asia, making its policy of containment, a global policy, which helped Japan's struggling post-war economy. Lastly, the Korean War ended Truman's resistance to a major military buildup. Between 1950 and 1953, the military budget grew from one-third of the federal budget to two-thirds of the budget.
