If the child is accompanied by only one parent, the parent should have a note from the child's other parent. For example, "I acknowledge that my wife/ husband is traveling out of the country with my son/ daughter.

Minor Travel Consent Form - U.S. Passport Service Guide

Documentation requirements become more complicated when one parent or guardian is traveling alone with a minor. In general, besides your passport, you should bring written consent from the child's biological parent(s) along with the child's birth certificate. Many countries require that the consent document be witnessed and notarized.

Travel Overseas | Homeland Security

This form is strongly recommended if a child is traveling alone, with only one parent, or with an authorized adult. It notifies others that the child has written permission or legal authority to travel without their parent(s). Travel can occur either across state lines or across country borders.

Parental Permission to Travel with Minors | USA Today

An immigration officer, airline, or travel company may ask for a letter of consent if the child is traveling internationally with only one parent or with another adult, such as a relative, friend, teacher, etc.

Child Traveling With One Parent

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) strongly recommends that unless the child is accompanied by both parents, the adult have a note from the child's other parent (or, in the case of a child traveling with grandparents, uncles or aunts, sisters or brothers, friends, or in groups*, a note signed by both parents) stating "I acknowledge that my wife/husband/etc. is traveling out of the country with my son/daughter/group. He/She/They has/have my permission."

Parental consent forms aren't required for all international destinations or for travel within the U.S., but the U.S. Department of State recommends that a child carries one if he is not traveling...

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTAL/GUARDIAN APPROVAL FOR MINOR TO ...

A Travel Consent Letter is used when a child is traveling alone, with only one parent/legal guardian, or with an authorized group. This document notifies authorities or other interested parties that a parent or legal guardian has given their consent for the child to travel without them.

Children - Child traveling with one parent or someone who ...

If a child (under the age of 18) is traveling with only one parent or with someone who is not a parent or legal guardian, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) strongly recommends that the accompanying adult have a note from the non-traveling parent (or, in the case of a child traveling with neither parent, a note signed by both parents) stating "I acknowledge that my wife/husband/etc. is traveling out of the country with my son/daughter/group.

Easy Solo Parent Guide to Using a Child Travel Consent Form

Providing proof of the relationship between the child and parents verifies a Child Travel Consent. Separated parents should carry guardianship forms, like a Child Travel Consent form, stating that both parents agree to the child traveling in the care of one parent. A letter of consent to travel with one parent can save separated parents a great deal of trouble at the border.

Child Travel Consent Form Due to the increase in child trafficking and abductions, if your minor child is traveling with only one parent, or without their parents or legal guardians, you may be asked to provide a travel consent letter to a TSA agent when boarding a plane, or an immigration officer when traveling internationally.

Recommended consent letter for children travelling abroad ...

The letter should indicate who the parents are, and explicitly express permission from the non-present parent that he or she grants permission for the child to travel with the guardian/parent present. The letter should also state the trip's duration, destination and how both parents can be contacted.

Free Consent Forms for Minors Traveling Without Parents

If one legal parent is traveling outside the United States with a minor child, this form should be signed by the legal parent that is not traveling. If a minor child is traveling outside the United States with someone other than either legal parent, BOTH legal parents should sign this form. If one or both legal parents are deceased, a certified death

But if your minor child will be traveling out of the country alone, with one parent, or with someone other than a parent or legal guardian, he will likely need to carry a notarized letter of consent (and perhaps a medical letter of consent) signed by his parents in addition to the unaccompanied minor program paperwork.
