An immigration officer, airline, or travel company may ask for a letter of consent if the child is traveling internationally with only one parent or with another adult, such as a relative, friend, teacher, etc. You can download the minor travel consent form in PDF format at the bottom of the page. 3.2 Where only one parent is travelling with a child, (or children), each child has to produce a valid passport, a BC or Equivalent Document for each travelling child and the Parental Consent Affidavit from the non-travelling parent whose details are recorded on the BC or Equivalent Document.

Get permission to take a child abroad - GOV.UK

A consent letter demonstrates that the child has permission to travel abroad, away from parent (s) or legal guardian (s) who are not accompanying them. It may be requested by authorities when a child enters or leaves a foreign country or by Canadian officials when the child re-enters Canada.

Alternatively, the applying parent may submit one of the following documents: Child's birth certificate listing only applying parent; Court order granting sole custody to the applying parent. Child's travel must not be restricted by that order; Death certificate of non-applying parent, or judicial declaration of incompetence of non-applying ...

LETTER OF CONSENT FOR TRAVEL OF A MINOR CHILD

A Child Travel Consent is a document or letter carried to prove that the child has the permission of the absent lawful parent (s) or guardian to travel. When the parents are separated or divorced, one parent should get consent from the other parent to travel with the child.

Required Documents for International Travel With Minors

The U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) recommends if a child is traveling with one (1) parent, especially if the parents are divorced, to carry a note from the other parent stating their consent to the trip. The note can be as simple as the following:

If the child is traveling with one of their parents it is not required. Fill out the form on the INM website with information about the child, the parent giving permission and, in the case of the child traveling with a third party, that person's name, birthdate and passport information.

Recommended consent letter for children travelling abroad. We strongly recommend that Canadian children carry a consent letter if they are travelling abroad alone, with only one parent/guardian, with friends or relatives or with a group. For the purposes of this consent letter, a Canadian child is defined as anyone who is under the age of majority (18 or 19, depending on the province or territory of residence).

Because of increasing instances of child abduction in custody cases, and a growing number of children who are the victims of trafficking or pornography, an immigration officer, airline, or travel company may ask you to provide some form of letter of consent if your child is traveling internationally with only one parent or with another adult, such as a grandparent, aunt, uncle, etc.

Child Travelling With One Parent

If a child (under the age of 18) is traveling with only one parent or with someone who is not a parent or legal guardian, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) strongly recommends that the accompanying adult have a note from the non-traveling parent (or, in the case of a child traveling with neither parent, a note signed by both parents) stating "I acknowledge that my wife/husband/etc. is traveling out of the country with my son/daughter/group.

the parent travelling with the child should carry copies of the legal custody documents. It is also best to have a letter of authorization from the other parent who has custody to take the child on a trip out of the country. If the parents are separated or divorced and one of them has sole custody of the child:

This form is strongly recommended if a child is traveling alone, with only one parent, or with an authorized adult. It notifies others that the child has written permission or legal authority to travel without their parent (s). Travel can occur either across state lines or across country borders.

Documentation requirements become more complicated when one parent or guardian is traveling alone with a minor. In general, besides your passport, you should bring written consent from the child's biological parent(s) along with the child's birth certificate. Many countries require that the consent document be witnessed and notarized.
