In a divorce, the only legal ground for commencing proceedings is an irretrievable breakdown of the marriage. To prove this, there can either be justifications based on fault (adultery, unreasonable behaviour or desertion) or non-fault (). For the latter, 3 years of separation is required in cases of non-contested divorces. For contested divorces, 4 years of separation is required.
