Effective for tax periods beginning after 2013, the credit for COBRA premium assistance payments can't be claimed on Form 941, Employer's QUARTERLY Federal Tax Return (or Form 944, Employer's ANNUAL Federal Tax Return).

The Hospital Insurance (Medicare) tax rate remained unchanged for both employee and employer at 1.45 percent. This change made the FICA tax rate for employees 5.65 percent, and the combined employee-employer FICA tax rate 13.3 percent for 2011 and 2012. Social Security tax is applied only up to a certain wage base, currently \$132,900.

Employers must use the 6.2% tax rate no later than Feb. 15, 2013. Adjustments should be made in a subsequent pay period to correct any under withholding of Social Security tax as a result of using the 4.2% withholding rate in 2013. Additional Medicare tax withholding.

FICA Taxes. Medicare (employer pays 1.45%) As of 2013, an Additional Medicare tax is applied to employees who file taxes as head of household, single or as a qualifying widow(er) with a dependent child and whose Medicare wages exceed \$200,000. The threshold is much lower for married individuals who file separate tax returns: \$125,000.

Federal Income Tax Withholding on Wages. FIT is computed based on current tax tables and on the designations and exemptions claimed by the employee on his or her W-4 form. Generally, most types of payments paid to employees by the state of Texas are considered to be subject to FIT, including base salary, longevity, hazardous duty, overtime and benefit replacement pay.

Unemployment Tax Information - Texas Workforce Commission

The social security tax rate is 6.2% each for the employee and employer, unchanged from 2013. The social security wage base limit is \$117,000. The Medicare tax rate is 1.45% each for the employee and employer, unchanged from 2013. There is no wage base limit for Medicare tax.

Interest Tax Rate. The Interest Tax Rate is used to pay interest on federal loans to Texas, if owed, used to pay unemployment benefits. This percentage will be the same for all employers in a given year. The Interest Tax is calculated according to Commission Rule. The Interest Tax Rate for 2018 is 0.00 percent.
