Physical/Behavioral Signs/Symptoms: A variety of different symptoms may occur, though some fish exhibit no external symptoms. Hemorrhaging of internal organs, skin and muscle. Bulging eyes.

Bloated abdomens. Bruised-looking, reddish tints to eyes, skin, gills and fins. Open sores. Abnormal behavior.
