20 Wilderness Survival Tips!

We'd recommend packing some canopy or tarpaulin, rope, some pegs or poles, a blanket or sleeping bag and a pocket knife before heading out into the wilderness, especially if you think you'll still be outdoors overnight. At the minimum, a rope and a sheet of waterproof tarpaulin is enough to build a good shelter outdoors.

To build the wedge tarp shelter, stake down two corners of the tarp into the wind (not opposing corners). Then tie up a line to the center of the opposite side of the tarp. Tie the remaining two corners down toward the ground.
