Lead-free solders have been increasing in use due to regulatory requirements plus the health and environmental benefits of avoiding lead-based electronic components. They are almost exclusively used today in consumer electronics. Plumbers often use bars of solder, much thicker than the wire used for electrical applications.

Lead-free solder is solder without lead. EU requires commercially available electronics to use lead-free solder (RHoS) because of the health hazards of lead. It has a higher melting point, so it is a bit harder to work with, but usually not a problem.

About Lead-Free and RoHS RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) is a European Union directive that restricts the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, chromium (VI), PBBs, and PBDEs in electrical and electronic equipment as of July 1, 2006.

These mandates will force the electronics industry to convert from solders that have traditionally contained small amounts of lead (Pb) to alternatives that are Pb-free.
