Threadmill and Thread Milling FAQ What is Thread Milling? Thread milling is an alternative to tapping on CNC machines for cutting threads. It works by moving a cutter along a helical path that corresponds to the thread's helix.

rotation the same as closing of the half nuts on a manual lathe would do. So, the threading is activated with an index pulse. As the defined length of thread is reached the controller moves the tool out of the thread based on the gcode file. Thus the X axis retracts while the Z axis is still moving but over a defined distance.

Tap Feed Calculator Instructions This is used to calculate feed rates for rigid tapping in CNC Enter Threads per inch (not pitch, i.e. 32 or 20) Enter the spindle speed in revolutions per minute. Result will be the feed rate in inches per minute. CNC machines usually need only 2 decimal places accuracy for feed rates.

Milling operations remove material by feeding a workpiece into a rotating cutting tool with sharp teeth, such as an end mill or face mill. Calculations use the desired tool diameter, number of teeth, cutting speed, and cutting feed, which should be chosen based on the specific cutting conditions, including the workpiece material and tool ...

### **Tapping Formulas and Calculations**

Take this example, in which a Harvey Tool threadmill #70094, with a .370" cutter diameter, is machining a 9/16-18 internal thread in 17-4 stainless steel. The calculated speed is 2,064 RPM and the linear feed is 8.3 IPM. The thread diameter of a 9/16 thread is .562", which is used for the inner and outer diameter in both adjustments.
