Salinger published Franny and Zooey in 1961, and Raise High the Roof Beam, Carpenters and Seymour: An Introduction in 1963. Each book contained two short stories or novellas, previously published in The New Yorker, about members of the Glass family.These four stories were originally published between 1955 and 1959, and were the only ones Salinger had published since Nine Stories.
