What is project management maturity?

At Level 1 of the organizational change management maturity model, project teams are not aware of change management and do not consider it as a formal approach for managing the people side of change. Use at the Project Level: Change management is applied on a project only as a last resort when employee resistance jeopardizes the success of the project.
