TCIA is a service which de-identifies and hosts a large archive of medical images of cancer accessible for public download. Motion artifact is a patient-based artifact that occurs with voluntary or involuntary patient movement during image acquisition.. Misregistration artifacts, which appear as blurring, streaking, or shading, are caused by patient movement during a CT scan. Blurring also occurs with patient movement during radiographic examinations.
