Although only necessary for more complex elements, here is a simple example: (a) lions, (b) tigers, and (c) bears. Items and phrasing should be parallel. Numbered Lists (APA 7, Section 6.51)

Capitalization: Use CMS headline style for titles and subtitles of books and articles: Capitalize first and last words of title and subtitle, if any; capitalize other major words, i.e., nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs. Book titles, journal titles: Set in italics. For titles with subtitles, if the title ends in a question mark, do not include a colon before the subtitle.
