DEFINITION OF SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS (SMI)

It stated "severe mental illness is defined through diagnosis, disability, and duration, and includes disorders with psychotic symptoms such as schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, manic depressive disorder, autism, as well as severe forms of other disorders such as major depression, panic disorder, and obsessive compulsive disorder.It came to similar conclusions as CMHS.

ADULTS (18 AND OLDER) Many of the components of the Federal definition were incorporated into the definition. As a result, the definition was broadened to include more individuals and the title was changed to "severe and persistent mental illness."
