Twenty years ago, in November, the effort to repeal the Oregon Death with Dignity Act failed and implementation of the law began. In the two decades since the law started providing peace of mind to dying Oregonians, the Death with Dignity National Center defended the policy in state and federal courts.

The phrase "death with dignity" has heavy emotional connotations but lacks a concrete definition. This article analyzes the meaning of this expression for both adults and children. In adults, death with dignity is based on respect for autonomy and includes several practices: advance directive planning, physician-assisted suicide, and euthanasia.

### **Towards death with dignity: Caring for dying people ...**

Dignity in Dying support the legislation of assisted dying (as legal in Oregon under the Oregon Death with Dignity Act), whereby a doctor prescribes a life-ending dose of medication to a mentally competent, terminally ill adult at the patient's request, and which the patient administers. This is different to assisted suicide, whereby somebody provides assistance to die to a person who is not terminally ill, and euthanasia, which involves a third party administering the life-ending medication ...

Background: Death with dignity (DWD) refers to the refusal of life-prolonging measures for terminally ill patients by "living wills" forms in advance. More and more oncology physicians are receiving DWD requests from advance cancer patients in mainland China.
