Outcome statements/objectives play an important role in helping students learn. They orient the student to the learning task and specify what students should pay attention to. They also help to focus the teacher to the goal of instruction, the central purpose, which is learning for the students or learners.. Outcome statements can be broad & comprehensive in scope (sometimes called program ...

How to Write SMART Learning Objectives | Convergence Training

The key to writing learning objectives is to make them SMART: Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, and Timely. Your assessment will tell you whether your objective was specific and measurable enough, while the lesson context dictates the objective's attainability, relevance, and timeliness.
